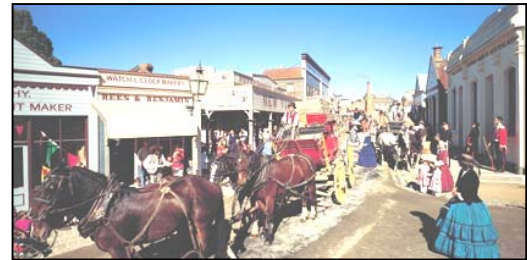


ROCK & ROLL
