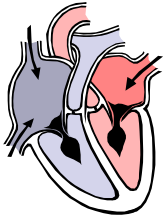


This poetry form has five lines: each line adds depth to the subject.

### Lungs

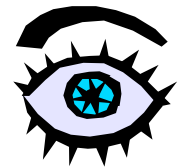
Slimy, veiny

### Stomach

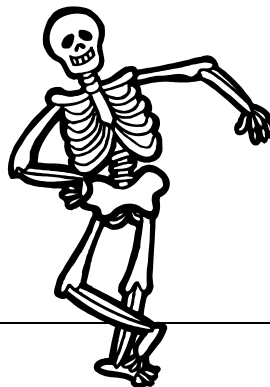
Cramped, acidic
